This is a flexible walking or cycling tour that uses 5 Burren hostels as stop-off points on a Grand Burren Tour. The routes are designed to ensure you experience the best that the area has to offer, especially those areas not readily accessible by car or on a coach.

Each hostel is a member of the Burren Ecotourism Network, and they work together to promote responsible tourism that conserves the environment and improves the well-being of local people.
